#### RESOLUTION NO. 17-04-089

**EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES (BFAR) THRU OFFICER-IN-CHARGE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO FIELD OFFICE, MR. RUPERTO N. ALFORQUE TO GRANT GILL NETS, HOOKS AND LINES AND ARTIFICIAL CORAL REEFS TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO FOR THE BENEFIT OF MARGINALIZED FISHERMEN**

**"WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is composed of eight (8) coastal barangays whose residents depend on fishing for a living;

**"WHEREAS**, strict implementation of Republic Act No. 8550 in this Municipality prohibits big commercial fishing vessels such as "pangulong" to catch fish within fifteen (15) kilometers away from the shorelines and likewise prohibits the use of active fishing gears thereby displacing fisherfolks and marginalized fishermen; hence, they need to be provided with an alternative livelihood program that fits their skills and needs;

**"WHEREAS**, one feasible passive fishing activity is the use of gill nets and hooks and lines which are considered sustainable for such fishing materials do not cause any destruction to the fishing ground; thus, providing continuous and equal opportunities to all fishermen to catch fish for everyday living;

"WHEREAS, artificial coral reefs serve as a sanctuary where fish and other aquatic life are able to spawn, reproduce and grow; Now, therefore, be it






