RESOLUTION NO. 20-09-388

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES (BFAR) TO INFORM THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO ON THE PRESENT STATUS OF FISHPONDS WITHIN BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) is a government agency under the Department of Agriculture responsible for the development, improvement, management and conservation of the country's fisheries and aquatic resources, it was reconstituted as a line bureau by virtue of Republic Act No. 8550 (Philippine Fisheries Code 1998);

"WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 8550 states that the municipal/city government, in consultation with the FARMC shall be responsible for the management, conservation, development, protection, utilization, and disposition of all fish and fishery/aquatic resources within their respective municipal waters;

"WHEREAS, Section 1 of Fisheries Administrative Order No. 197: Series of 2000 defined the Fishpond Lease as an agreement entered into by and between the Secretary of Agriculture and qualified fishpond applicant for the use of public land for fishpond development purposes for a period of twenty-five (25) years;

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao, has eight (8) coastal barangays whose major source of income of the residents is fishing. It is acclaimed as the fishing capital of the Province of Oriental Mindoro transporting large volume of fish and other marine products to nearby provinces and Metro Manila;

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao, a coastal municipality has a total fishpond area of 244.9 hectares, 74 hectares of which have Fishpond Lease Agreement (FLA) and only 24 hectares of those are operational, and it is unfortunate that because of no capital other fishponds are not operating;

"WHEREAS, to know the present status of the fishponds in Bulalacao will help determine the needs of the non-operational fishponds, it would be advantageous not only for the fishpond owners but also to the municipal government of Bulalacao because it will maximize the unused area and will provide income for both;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT, RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: request the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) to inform the Local Government of Bulalacao on the present status of fishponds within Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro.
