EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM TO ALLOCATE THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO (2) HANGING BRIDGES CONNECTING BALATASAN PENINSULA TO TAMBARON ISLAND AND TO MAASIN ISLAND IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN MILLION PESOS EACH (PHP10M) UNDER ITS TOURISM ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS (TRIP)

"WHEREAS, Barangay Maasin, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is an isolated island barangay and the smallest in land area with only 231.57 hectares and probably in population whose major source of income of the inhabitants is fishing;

"WHEREAS, Maasin Island is situated at the southeastern part of the Municipality of Bulalacao which is seven (7) kilometers away from the town proper which could be reach through motor boats only. Maasin is declared as tourism zone and marine reserved island due to its rich marine resources claimed as the major supplier of large varieties of fishes and seashells;








