RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE PROVINCIAL AGRICULTURE OFFICE, ORIENTAL MINDORO THRU THE PROVINCIAL AGRICULTURIST, MS. CHRISTINE M. PINE TO EXTEND TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO IN ESTABLISHING DIFFERENT COMMODITY COUNCILS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 7581 declares that it is the policy of the State to ensure the availability of basic necessities and prime commodities at reasonable prices at all times without denying legitimate business a fair return on investment, it is also a declared policy of the State to provide effective and sufficient protection to consumers against hoarding, profiteering and cartels with respect to the supply, distribution, marketing and pricing of said goods, especially during periods of calamity, emergency, widespread illegal price manipulation and other similar situations;

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao, a 3rd class municipality with a population of 39,107 based on 2015 census, has 15 barangays and total agricultural land area of 10,325.80 hectares with 6,016 registered individuals employed in the agricultural sector, it has a tropical climate type conducive to planting of staple crops such as rice and corn including garlic, onions and varieties of vegetables and fruits being transported to Manila and nearby provinces, it also used to be known as supplier of large cattle and other livestock animals in the province;


"WHEREAS, it is important to establish different commodity councils in this municipality to have cross-functional teams responsible for strategizing the enterprise-wide sourcing of certain categories of products and/or services at the lowest cost;

"WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao is ideating and pushing to have different commodity councils for each sector of industry such as in agriculture, fishery and livestock market to protect both its suppliers and consumers from unjust price manipulation, thus it would be needing technical and financial support from higher offices to finally begin its establishment which would benefits the municipality as a whole; Now, therefore, be it...


