SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 16-09-44

SPECIAL ORDINANCE GRANTING ONE-TIME SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM CONTRIBUTION FOR ONE MONTH TO ALL BARANGAY DAY CARE WORKERS, BARANGAY TANODS, BARANGAY HEALTH WORKERS, BARANGAY NUTRITION SCHOLARS, BARANGAY UTILITY WORKERS, BARANGAY JUSTICES, BARANGAY SECRETARIES, BARANGAY TREASURERS, PUNONG BARANGAYS, BARANGAY KAGAWADS AND SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OFFICIALS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND PROVIDING MECHANISM THEREFOR

“**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Code of 1991 gave way to the devolution of powers from the central government down to basic government units;

“**WHEREAS**, such devolution created the Sangguniang Barangay as the primary government operation machinery in every community and powers were delineated and assigned so as to uphold the general welfare of its constituents;

“**WHEREAS**, the same Code provides that municipal government units must maintain harmonious and effective partnerships with other local government units and provide necessary support especially to Sangguniang Barangays;

“WHEREAS, barangay officials, workers and volunteers are receiving compensation from the government in honorarium basis although they perform various and sometimes complicated works;

“WHEREAS, this grant is recognition to the selfless services rendered by these unsung heroes and agents of change in their respective communities;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, That:

SECTION 1. STATEMENT OF POLICY. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro to uphold its mandate in providing group insurance or additional insurance coverage for barangay officials, including members of barangay tanod brigades and other services units with public or private insurance companies, when the finances of the municipal government allow said coverage.

SEC. 2. ENTITLEMENT. All of the following barangay officials, workers and volunteers shall be granted one-time one month lowest applicable contribution to Social Security System:

- a. Barangay Day Care Workers
- b. Barangay Tanods and members of Barangay Peace Action Teams
- c. Barangay Health Workers
- d. Barangay Nutrition Scholars
- e. Barangay Utility Workers
- f. Barangay Justices
- g. Barangay Secretaries
- h. Barangay Treasurers
- i. Punong Barangays
- j. Barangay Kagawads
- k. Sangguniang Kabataan officials

SEC. 3. REQUIREMENTS. Submission of the following requirements shall be required prior to the grant:

- a. Oath of office or appointment paper
- b. Birth Certificate
- c. SSS approved enrolment form with SSS number on it
- d. Duly accomplished and signed payment form

The Heads or Acting Heads of the following offices shall help in enrolling the herein cited officials, workers and volunteers:

- a. Liga ng mga Barangay
- b. Municipal Health Office
- c. Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office
- d. Municipal Local Government Operations Office

The Office of the Sangguniang Bayan or the Office of the Municipal Administrator shall consolidate the duly filled out enrolment form with attached requirements and shall coordinate with the most practical-to-transact-with or nearest branch of the Social Security System for the mass enrolment of the beneficiaries of this grant. Enrolment must be completed on or before April 30, 2017.



SEC. 4. FUND. There shall be allocation for this grant in the Office of the Municipal Mayor and in Sangguniang Barangays in 2017 Annual Budget under maintenance and other operating expenses. Seventy percent (70%) of the amount shall be provided by the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao and the remaining thirty percent (30%) shall be provided by the Sangguniang Barangays. Counterpart from the Sangguniang Barangays shall be paid to the Municipal Treasury Office. Total amount of this grant, shall be paid by the Municipal Treasury Office to the nearest branch of the Social Security System, subject to usual accounting rules and regulations and upon submission of the required documents. Copies of machine validated payment form shall be distributed to members within ten (10) days after such payment was made.

SEC. 5. SENIOR CITIZENS. Barangay officials, workers and volunteers who are sixty (60) years old and above and not yet SSS member who paid at least one (1) month contribution shall be granted similar benefit accorded to a member who paid even just a single contribution to Social Security System, provided they are incumbent of their respective positions or they have rendered at least ten (10) years of service. The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office shall ensure that this provision be given utmost consideration.

SEC. 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 01, 2017. There shall be no retroactive effect of this Ordinance.






