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MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 19-09-240

ORDINANCE FIXING THE DAILY WAGE RATE OF LABORERS, SKILLED WORKERS, AND FOREMEN IN GOVERNMENT PROJECTS WITHIN BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO AND REPEALING SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 14-02-06-A

WHEREAS, thru enabling laws, the Regional Tripartite Wages and Productivity Boards set the minimum wage rate of private sector workers in different regions across the country;

WHEREAS, it is ironic that there are times when workers in government projects receive lesser wages compared to workers in private sector;

WHEREAS, it has been noted in this municipality that fewer laborers and skilled workers would accept job orders in public works because non-government projects offer higher daily wage rate;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao must address this concern in order to promote and uphold labor and employment, just compensation, and social justice.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, that:

Section 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "2019 Wages in Government Projects Ordinance of Bulalacao".

Section 2. Statement of Policy. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao (LGU of Bulalacao) to support daily wage earners within this municipality in order to help them cope up with the costly demands of day-to-day living, and to cause the immediate implementation of government projects for the benefit and general welfare of the public.

Section 3. Daily Wage Rate. The minimum wage rate of workers in projects implemented by any government agency or instrumentality in Bulalacao shall be fixed as follows:

Classification of Worker	Minimum Daily Wage Rate
Laborer	PhP 320.00
Skilled Worker (like carpenter, mason, painter, etc.)	PhP 450.00
Foreman	PhP 550.00

The program of works (POW), work and financial plan, appointment, and payroll of every government project in Bulalacao shall reflect this adjustment.

The wage of workers in private sector shall conform to the most recent minimum wage rate set by the Regional Tripartite Wages and Productivity Board.

The wage rate of job order and contract of service workers of the LGU of Bulalacao shall conform to the Civil Service Commission (CSC), Commission on Audit (COA), and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 1, series of 2018 or to Municipal Ordinance No. 17-02-177, whichever may give the higher rate.

The Municipal Engineering Office (MEO) shall coordinate with different government agencies that have projects in the municipality, and if necessary, the Public Employment Service Unit (PESU) shall coordinate with private sector, regarding the implementation of this Ordinance. The Human Resource Management Unit, MEO, and PESU shall ensure that the wages of job order and contract of service workers of the LGU of Bulalacao, including of those who work in intermittent basis in projects, are in accordance with most recent policies and laws.

Section 4. Administrative Provision. (a) The Secretary to the Sangguniang Bayan and the sponsors shall orient the concerned employees and stakeholders regarding this Ordinance during the Legislative Forum which shall be held every last Wednesday of the month.

Handwritten signatures and initials of the Sangguniang Bayan members and sponsors, including a large circular mark on the left.

(b) Any officer or employee of the LGU of Bulalacao who shall disregard or neglect the implementation of this Ordinance shall be administratively dealt with and such shall be a ground for suspension or dismissal subject to pertinent provisions of the Civil Service Commission laws and rules.

Section 5. Repealing Clause. Special Ordinance No. 14-02-06-A is hereby repealed. Any provision of other ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are likewise repealed or modified.

Section 6. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect. Higher laws or policies inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

Section 7. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after fifteen (15) days of posting in bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao.
