MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 19-07-232

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING INCENTIVES TO BULALACAONON PUPILS,
STUDENTS, TRAINEES, AND LEARNERS WHO WON IN DIFFERENT
ACADEMIC AND SKILL COMPETITIONS FROM DIVISION TO HIGHER
LEVELS**

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 13 of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines provides that "The State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being";

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro (LGU of Bulalacao) positions Bulalacao to become the center of academic excellence in the province of Oriental Mindoro and therefore supports Bulalacaonon pupils, students, trainees, and learners who excel in academic and skill competitions in different levels;

WHEREAS, the package of incentives is a proof of the LGU of Bulalacao's sincere commitment to pursue, maintain, and sustain the Education for All Program and to actively support the children and youth in their worthy undertakings and encourage academic and skill excellence among them;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, that:

Section 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as "The 2019 Ordinance on Granting Incentives to Bulalacaonon Winners in Academic and Skill Competitions".

Section 2. Declaration of Policy. It is the policy of the LGU of Bulalacao to grant incentives to pupils, students, trainees, and learners who participated and won in different academic and skill competitions from division to higher levels.

Section 3. Incentives. (a) The following incentives shall be granted to qualified pupils, students, trainees, and learners:

(b) The financial incentive shall be always granted with a certificate or plaque of recognition.

(c) The official coach or chaperone shall be also conferred with a certificate or plaque of recognition.

(d) The certificate or plaque shall bear the official logo of the LGU of Bulalacao and shall have the signature of the municipal mayor being the official representative of the agency.

(e) As much as possible, the awarding ceremonies shall be done during the education night as part of the municipal festival or founding anniversary celebration.

Section 4. Rules and Regulations. The following rules and regulations shall be observed and respected:

(a) The head of preparatory, elementary or high school where the winner is enrolled shall submit a letter addressed to the municipal mayor recommending the conferment of incentives to the qualified pupil or student and to the official coach or chaperone, and attesting the result of a particular competition. A certification from the concerned authority stating that a Bulalacaonon pupil and student won a particular competition and indicating therein the official coach or chaperone shall be attached to such letter.

(b) The ALS learner, techvoc trainee, or college student shall submit a letter addressed to the municipal mayor requesting the conferment of incentives. A certification from the concerned authority stating that a Bulalacaonon learner, trainee or student won a particular competition and indicating therein the official coach or chaperone shall be attached to such letter.

A series of approximately ten handwritten signatures in black ink, likely representing the officials mentioned in the ordinance, such as the municipal mayor and members of the Sangguniang Bayan.

- (c) All pupils, students, learners, trainees, coaches, or chaperones as may be entitled of the incentives mentioned in this Ordinance shall be conferred with such incentives regardless of political interest or affiliation, religious belief, gender preference, cultural group, or educational attainment;
- (d) There shall be no unnecessary delays in granting the incentives;
- (e) The Municipal Budget Officer shall make sure that fund for this purpose is set aside and always available all year round;
- (f) The Education Unit or its equivalent in the Office of the Municipal Mayor shall be responsible in the preparation and processing of voucher and other documents pertinent to the incentives. It shall exert efforts in the preparation and conferment of the certificate or plaque. It shall also take charge in all matters concerning the implementation of this Ordinance;
- (g) The grant shall be subject to availability of funds and to usual accounting rules and regulations, and documents to be required by the Municipal Accounting Office shall be complied with;
- (h) The implementation of this Ordinance shall commence in 2020 when fund is already available.


Section 5. Fund. The fund needed for the implementation of this ordinance shall be included in the Annual Budget and Annual Investment Program for the fiscal year 2020 and years thereafter and shall be charged under the existing and related appropriation under Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses of the Office of the Municipal Mayor. The Municipal Budget Officer based on recommendation of Education Services Focal Person or its equivalent in the Office of the Municipal Mayor shall ensure that the budget necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance is included in yearly appropriation. The fund appropriated for this purpose shall not be allowed for realignment and not be certified as savings unless it served its purpose already within a particular fiscal year.

Section 6. Penalty. Any officer or employee of the LGU of Bulalacao who shall disregard or neglect the implementation of this Ordinance shall be administratively dealt with and such shall be a ground for suspension or dismissal subject to pertinent provisions of the Civil Service Laws and Rules.

Section 7. Repealing Clause. Any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 8. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect. Higher laws or policies inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

Section 9. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after fifteen (15) days of posting in bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao.




