ORDINANCE MODIFYING SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 16-09-44 ENTITLED SPECIAL ORDINANCE "GRANTING ONE - TIME SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM CONTRIBUTION FOR ONE MONTH TO ALL BARANGAY DAY CARE WORKERS, BARANGAY TANODS, BARANGAY HEALTH WORKERS, BARANGAY NUTRITION SCHOLARS, BARANGAY UTILITY WORKERS, BARANGAY JUSTICES, BARANGAY SECRETARIES, BARANGAY TREASURERS, PUNONG BARANGAYS, BARANGAY KAGAWADS, AND SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OFFICIALS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND PROVIDING MECHANISM THEREFOR"

"WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 gave way to the devolution of powers from the central government down to basic government units;

"WHEREAS, such devolution created the Sangguniang Barangay as the primary government operation machinery in every community, and powers were delineated and assigned so as to uphold the general welfare of its constituents;

"WHEREAS, the same Code provides that municipal government units must maintain harmonious and effective partnerships with other local government units and provide necessary support especially to Sangguniang Barangays;

"WHEREAS, barangay officials, workers, and volunteers are receiving compensation from the government in honorarium basis although they perform various and sometimes complicated works;

"WHEREAS, this grant is recognition to the selfless services rendered by these unsung heroes and agents of change in their respective communities;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, that:

SECTION 1. STATEMENT OF POLICY. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro to uphold its mandate in providing group insurance or additional insurance coverage for barangay officials, including members of barangay tanod brigades and other service units, with public or private insurance companies, when the finances of the municipal government allow said coverage.

SECTION 2. ENTITLEMENT. All of the following barangay officials, workers and volunteers shall be granted one - time one month applicable contribution to the Social Security System:


- a. Barangay child development workers
- b. Barangay tanods and members of Barangay Peace Action Teams
- c. Barangay health workers
- d. Barangay nutrition scholars
- e. Barangay bookkeepers
- f. Barangay utility workers
- g. Barangay justices
- h. Barangay secretaries
- i. Barangay treasurers
- j. Punong barangays
- k. Barangay kagawads
- l. Sangguniang kabataan officials
- m. Other barangay workers as maybe allowed by laws and ordinances.

SECTION 3. REQUIREMENTS. The following requirements shall be submitted to MSWDO prior to the grant:

- a. Oath of office or appointment paper
- b. Birth certificate authenticated by the Philippine Statistics Authority
- c. SSS-approved enrolment form with SSS number on it

The heads or acting heads of the following offices shall help in enrolling the herein cited officials, workers and volunteers:

- a. Liga ng mga Barangay
- b. Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO)
- c. Municipal Local Government Operations Office (MLGOO)

All Sangguniang Barangays shall submit the list of officials, workers, and volunteers with SSS numbers to MSWDO. Names of those who have no SSS number yet shall also be submitted to MSWDO which shall coordinate with the most practical-to-transact-with or nearest branch of the Social Security System for mass membership enrolment. Enrolment must be completed on or before December 31, 2018.

Barangay secretaries shall inform MSWDO if there would be new officials, workers, or volunteers within one (1) month after appointment or election for their subsequent enrolment to SSS and for their inclusion in the payment of one-time one month contribution.

SECTION 4. FUND. There shall be two hundred fifty thousand pesos (PhP 250,000.00) appropriation for this grant in the Office of the Municipal Mayor under maintenance and other operating expenses for fiscal year 2019. This fund shall not be allowed for realignment and not be certified as savings unless it already served its purpose for a particular fiscal year. The fund shall be augmented as needed.

The Municipal Budget Officer shall make sure that appropriation for succeeding years shall be always included in the annual budget, provided that such yearly appropriation shall not be lesser than fifteen thousand pesos (PhP 15,000.00). The Municipal Budget Officer shall ensure that the budget necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance is included in yearly appropriation.

One hundred percent (100%) of the applicable one month contribution for each member shall be paid by the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao thru the Municipal Treasury Office to the most practical-to-transact-with or nearest branch of the Social Security System, subject to usual accounting rules and regulations and upon submission of the required documents. Copies of machine validated payment document shall be distributed to members within ten (10) days after such payment was made.

Preparation and processing of vouchers and attachments shall be the responsibility of MSWDO. It shall also ensure that no double or more payments are made for every barangay official, worker, and volunteer except for barangay nutrition scholars and barangay health workers.

All barangay officials, workers, and volunteers shall be encouraged to continue paying contributions so that they may avail retirement and other benefits.

SECTION 5. SENIOR CITIZENS. Barangay officials, workers, and volunteers who are not members of SSS, or even though members but did not pay even a single contribution, or who are 60 years old and above and not yet SSS members who paid at least one (1) month contribution shall be granted similar benefit accorded to a member who paid even just a single contribution to Social Security System, provided they are incumbent of their respective positions or they have rendered at least ten (10) years of service. The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office shall ensure that this provision be given utmost consideration.

SECTION 6. PENALTY. Any officer or employee who shall disregard or neglect the implementation of this Ordinance shall be administratively dealt with and such shall be a ground for suspension or dismissal subject to the pertinent provisions of the Civil Service Laws and Rules.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. Provisions of Special Ordinance No. 16-09-44, or of any other ordinance, inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect. Higher laws or policies inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after fifteen (15) days of posting in bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao.
