AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING BULALACAO CHAMBER OF COMMERCE DETERMINING ITS OBJECTIVES, FUNCTIONS, INITIAL STRUCTURE, AMONG OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BULALACAO IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT;

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines is clear in its declaration that the State shall recognize the indispensable role of the private sector, encourage private enterprise, and provide incentive to needed investment;

WHEREAS, local government units have the responsibility to support and protect business and commerce operating within its territorial jurisdiction in order to attain robust local economy;

WHEREAS, the LGU of Bulalacao desires to organize entrepreneurs, business people, and investors to create an environment of support system which shall be conducive to different economic activities;

WHEREAS, there is a need for that organization as such would be of great help in the realization of poverty reduction goals of the LGU of Bulalacao.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, that:

Section 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Bulalacao Chamber of Commerce Ordinance of 2021"

Section 2. Statement of Policy. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao (LGU of Bulalacao) to support business and commerce, encourage entrepreneurship and investment, and pursue an environment conducive to economic activities, within its territorial jurisdiction.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. **Business** is an organization or economic system where goods and services are exchanged for one another or for money;
- b. **Commerce** is an economic activity, wherein exchange for goods and services for value or the activity of buying and selling, is done on a large scale;
- c. **Economy** refers to the wealth and resources of a particular area, especially in terms of the production and consumption of goods and services;
- d. **Entrepreneurship** refers to the activity of setting up a business or businesses, taking on financial risks in the hope of profit;
- e. **Local economy** is the economic system and range of economic activity in Bulalacao that serves the local population;
- f. **Industry** is an economic activity, concerned with the procurement and processing of raw materials into finished products, that reaches the customer;
- g. **Investment** refers to the action or process of investing money for profit or material result;

Section 4. Creation and Structure. The Bulalacao Chamber of Commerce (BCC) is hereby established with this initial and interim structure:

- (a) Business owners and operators, entrepreneurs, economic and industry players, and investors in Bulalacao shall elect among themselves the officers of the BCC - president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, auditor, and five (5) board of directors. The officers shall perform the usual functions of such positions.
- (b) The officers shall formulate constitution and by-laws (CBL) of the BCC for ratification by the general assembly within one (1) year after the organization of the interim structure. Provisions on basic principles, official seal and creed, objectives, membership and rights and duties of members, general assembly, officers and their functions, election and term of officers, regular and special meetings, amendments and ratification of CBL, and other pertinent concerns shall be included in the CBL. The BCC must be registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR), and with other government agencies as may be necessary within one (1) year after the ratification of the CBL.

(b) Any officer or employee of the LGU of Bulalacao who shall disregard or neglect the implementation of this Ordinance shall be administratively dealt with and such shall be a ground for suspension or dismissal subject to the pertinent provisions of the Civil Service Laws and Rules.

Section 8. Repealing Clause. Any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 9. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect. Higher laws or policies inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.

Section 10. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after fifteen (15) days of posting in bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao.
