EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE JOHN HENRY OSWERA, SENATOR, REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES TO ALLOCATE THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P300,000.00) TO BE USED FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWENTY (20) HEADS OF FEMALE CARABAOS FOR UPLAND FARMING OF QUALIFIED TRIBAL MEMBERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is the southernmost tip of the province whose population is composed of approximately twenty percent of Hanunuo-Mangyans;

"WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Bulalacao in an effort to uplift the living standard of these indigenous people adopted various strategies in livelihood programs which promote participation and involvement and enhance their skills and capabilities towards a self-reliant and happy community;


"WHEREAS, it is a known fact that our brothers and sisters in the mountainous region depend on upland farming to earn a living aside from the livelihood projects given to few due to limited funds;


"WHEREAS, the provision of female carabaos to qualified Tribal Member which would be under the supervision and monitoring of the Office of the Municipal Agriculture is expected to strengthen upland farming for increase rice production towards food stability for the Hanunuo-Mangyan; Now, therefore, be it


