"RESOLUTION NO. 99-02- 040

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE JOSEPH E. ESTRADA, PRESIDENT AND CONCURRENT SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT, THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY, CHAIRMAN OF THE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES TO PLEASE EXTEND THE TERMS OF LOCAL ELECTIVE OFFICIALS

"WHEREAS, Section 43 of Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "No local elective official shall serve for more than three (3) consecutive years in the same position . . .";

"WHEREAS, this three-year term limitation of the local elective officials is deemed to be too short as it impedes the continuity in the implementation of projects relevant to the needs of the constituents;

"WHEREAS, it is a common observation and considered to be a fact to prove that the present term of office proves to be too short on the following consideration; the newly elected local officials usually spends the first year of the term learning about the demands of the office; by the second year, reelection preoccupies the incumbent and by the third, their campaign usually begins in earnest;

"WHEREAS, seeing that there is too little time that can be spent in a sincere effort to discharge one's duties as local elective official, a Constitutional amendment thereto to lengthen must be effectuated; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request the Honorable Joseph E. Estrada, President, and concurrent

Secretary, Department of the Interior and Local Government, the Executive Secretary, Chairman of the oversight Committee on Local Government Code, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives to please extend the terms of local elective officials;
