**EARNESTLY REQUESTING HON. ALFONSO V. UMALI, JR. CONGRESSMAN, 2<sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO ALLOCATE MEDICINES FOR THE INDIGENT RESIDENTS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**“WHEREAS**, Section 15, Article II of the 1986 Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

**“WHEREAS**, it is sadly observed that life becomes more difficult each day that people could hardly cope up with their basic needs, particularly access to affordable medicines and basic medical services;

**“WHEREAS**, the Municipal Health Office at this Municipality which is manned by one physician, two nurses and a few number of midwives could not fully deliver effective and efficient medical services needed by the residents due to lack of medicines and inavailability of medical equipments;


**“WHEREAS**, being the Pro-poor Municipality pursuant to Executive Order No. 370 the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro which is composed of a population of a 20% Hanunuo Mangyans could not immediately augment the appropriation for health services, it, being hounded with financial constraint;


