RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING SECRETARY ARTHUR C. YAP, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE THROUGH THE BUREAU OF AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH (BAR) THE INCLUSION AND PRIORITIZATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO AS A POTENTIAL AREA FOR THE EXPANSION OF RUBBER FARMING/ PLANTATION PROJECT

"WHEREAS, with favorable climatic conditions and fertile soil suitable for growing rubber trees, the Provinces of Palawan, Mindoro Oriental and Mindoro Occidental were cited as potential areas for the planting of rubber trees which is of high commercial value;

"WHEREAS, in August 2008, the BAR funded project, Development and Promotion of Rubber Towards Commercialization in Oriental and Occidental Mindoro was launched to establish budwood gardens and nursery of five (5) recommended clones of rubber producing 10,000 quality planting materials;

"WHEREAS, this august body is in the stage of finding better solutions by way of providing alternative livelihood projects to our constituents especially those belonging to the Tribal Community of Hanunuo Mangyans who are presently engaged into massive commercial charcoal manufacturing; cutting-down the ipil-ipil trees which is not an environment-friendly activity;

"WHEREAS, the proposed expansion BAR-supported project on rubber farming in this municipality would greatly help our marginalized farmers avail of better source of income and simultaneously divert their attention from massive charcoal production;

"WHEREAS, this august body firmly believes that **"THE FUTURE BELONGS TO THOSE WHO PREPARES FOR IT"** and that we can achieve better future through the DA-BAR as our dynamic partner in the promotion and development of Environment-Friendly Projects; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED; TO: Earnestly request Secretary Arthur C. Yap, Department of Agriculture through the Bureau of Agricultural Research (BAR) the inclusion and prioritization of the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro as a potential area for the expansion of rubber farming/plantation project;






