EARNESTLY REQUESTING DIRECTOR EMMANUEL DE ASIS TO FACILITATE AN OCULAR INSPECTION AND SURVEY IN THE MUNICIPAL WATERS OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO SPECIFICALLY AT THE VICINITY OF THE ISLAND OF SILAD WHICH WAS DECLARED IN 2003 AS MARINE PROTECTED AREA AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHICH PORTION SHALL BE DECLARED AS FISH SANCTUARY

“WHEREAS, several islands in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro particularly Silad was declared to be Marine Protected Areas under Ordinance No. 03-05-032 in 2003;

“WHEREAS, such ordinance was enacted in the pursuit of the policy to achieve food security as the overriding consideration in the utilization, management, development, conservation and protection of fishing resources in order to provide to food needs of the population;

“WHEREAS, the declaration likewise aims to limit access to the fishing and aquatic resources of the municipal waters for the exclusive use and enjoyment of Bulalacao bonafide residents;


“WHEREAS, it is proper to adopt a flexible policy towards the attainment of food security in response to the changes in demographic trends for fish emerging trends in the trade of fish and order aquatic products in domestic and international markets and the law of supply and demand;


"WHEREAS, it shall be to the best interest of the marginal fisherfolks if there be done a reliable, scientific, comprehensive, reassessment and re-evaluation of the area in order to achieve the abovementioned goals, there is a need to establish an effective protective areas and spawning ground that is a Municipal Fish Sanctuary; Now, therefore, be it


RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request Director Emmanuel de Asis to facilitate an ocular inspection and survey in the Municipal Waters of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro specifically at the vicinity of the Island of Silad which was declared in 003 as Marine Protected Area and for the purpose of determining which portion shall be declared as Fish Sanctuary;


