"WHEREAS, in a rapidly globalizing economy, providing basic education is simply not enough that one must have a specific and marketable skills in order to enter and benefit from the formal labor market;

"WHEREAS, there is no tertiary school found in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro taking into consideration that public education is free up to the secondary level however; going any further entails substantial economic resources that many families of this town do not have enough financial capabilities to sustain their children to schools for even technical or vocational courses;

"WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro took the initiative of putting-up a vocational and technical college where young people shall be taught and trained in various skills such as welding and fabricating in order to equip them with the necessary specialized knowledge and skills needed for them to be employed in a rapidly growing industries here and abroad;

"WHEREAS, as of to date funds for the project were all taken from the local fund that it seeks financial assistance from the higher government agencies in order to ensure that this would be continuously and successfully implemented; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED; To: Request the Honorable Aquilino Martin Pimentel, Senator, Republic of the Philippines to allocate a Scholarship Grant amounting to One Million Pesos (Php1M) for the students of the Bulalacao Technical and Vocational College (BTVC) situated in Barangay San Roque, Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro;


