RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE PROVINCIAL ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICE (PENRO) THRU MISS MARY JUNE F. MAYPA, OFFICER-IN-CHARGE TO ASSIGN AT LEAST TEN (10) BANTAY BAKAWAN WORKERS TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao is composed of eight (8) coastal barangays whose major source of income of the residents is fishing;

“WHEREAS, mangrove trees grow well in coastal ecosystem within this Municipality and these trees are extremely important for the reproduction of fish, shrimps, reptiles and huge varieties of marine life;

“WHEREAS, mangrove trees serve as natural barriers and are critical components in the overall resilience of coastal areas to natural threats and disasters protecting not only animals and environment but also the people living around the seashore;

“WHEREAS, it is sad to see that huge mangrove areas are being destructed by unscrupulous persons who cut down trees for commercial and domestic uses and worst is, mangrove trees are made into charcoal;

“WHEREAS, taking into consideration the importance of mangrove to our ecosystem and to the protection of human lives and properties, it is imperative that proper care and management should be done before total destruction might become irreparable; Now, therefore, be it
