RESOLUTION NO. 21-02-086

RESOLUTION SEEKING UNDERSTANDING AND APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG) ON NON-COMPLIANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO DILG MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2020-036 ENTITLED "PROHIBITING TRICYCLES, PEDICABS AND MOTORIZED PEDICABS FROM OPERATING ON NATIONAL HIGHWAYS"

"WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2020-036 dated February 17, 2020 prohibits tricycles, pedicabs and motorized pedicabs from operating on national highways primarily for safety purposes;

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao is the last Municipality of the Province of Oriental Mindoro annex to the Province of Occidental Mindoro. Several years ago, through the joined efforts of both the local and the national government, a national highway was constructed to connect the two provinces for tourism and business partnerships to achieve social and economic development;

"WHEREAS, being the Pro-Poor Municipality pursuant to Executive Order No. 370, it has only a national highway for both local travellers and those who are going to Occidental Mindoro and vice versa and that there is no alternative route which could possibly be used by tricycles, pedicabs and motorized pedicabs;

"WHEREAS, rest assured that in the formulation of future plans of LGU-Bulalacao, road widening and road alternative routes should be given priority to ensure safety and also convenience of both the vehicles and pedestrians alike; **Now, therefore, be it**


RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Seek understanding and approval of the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) on non-compliance of the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro to DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2020-036 entitled "Prohibiting tricycles, pedicabs, and motorized pedicabs from operating on national highways";




