Morales of Naujan, did an inspiring share of her time, efforts and resources to extend continuous support and help through distribution of food and medicine and other relief goods to affected families within the sphere of her capacity to which her act of kindness and generosity truly deserves recognition and appreciation; Now, therefore be it....




