RESOLUTION NO. 20-01-035

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ORIENTAL MINDORO THRU GOVERNOR HUMERLITO "BONZ" DOLOR, CHAIRMAN, PROVINCIAL MINING AND REGULATORY BOARD (PMRB) TO GRANT MORATORIUM ON QUARRYING OF PEBBLES WITHIN THE COASTAL AREAS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, THIS PROVINCE

"WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao is amenable that it granted clearance and allowed the activity of quarrying of pebbles in certain coastal areas within the Municipality without serious study and assessment of its adverse effects to environment and the community;

"WHEREAS, quarrying is bad for the environment in several ways. It abruptly interrupt the continuity of open space, ruining habitats of flora and fauna, cause soil erosion, air and dust pollution hazardous to health, damage to coves, loss of land and deterioration in water quality;

"WHEREAS, upon the formulation of the Forest Land Use Plan of the Municipality, it was found out that the coastal areas where quarrying of pebbles is done is perfect to be developed into a tourism destination because of its pristine white sand beach and a beautiful rock formation and stunning panoramic view for the enjoyment and satisfaction of both the local and foreign tourists;

"WHEREAS, the moratorium that may be granted will give an ample time for the province and the Municipality of Bulalacao to conduct review and assessment on quarrying of pebbles that shall serve as reference in the formulation of future guidelines and policies in an effort to conserve and protect the environment; **Now, therefore, be it**

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED To: Earnestly request the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro thru Governor Humerlito "Bonz" Dolor, Chairman, Provincial Mining and Regulatory Board (PMRB) to grant moratorium on quarrying of pebbles within the coastal areas of the Municipality of Bulalacao, this Province;


