

ORDINANCE NO. 087

ENJOINING ALL OPERATORS OF BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO INFORM THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT IN CASE OF THEIR CLOSURE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS. When used in this Ordinance the term:

- (a) "Business" means trade or commercial activity regularly engaged in as a means of livelihood or with a view to profit;
- (b) "Operator" includes the owner, manager, administrator, or any other person who operates or is responsible for the operation of a business establishment on undertaking;

SECTION 2. REGULATED ACTS. All operators of business establishments in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro are hereby enjoined to inform the Municipal Government through the Office of the Municipal Treasurer in case of their closure or suspension of business;

SECTION 3. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISION. The Municipal Treasurer shall put into record the informations and all other facts given to him by the operator of a business establishment that intends to terminate its operation; Provided that such informations must be brought to the knowledge of the Office of the Municipal Treasurer within fifteen (15) days after the closure;


SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. Ordinances inconsistent hereof are hereby repealed, modified accordingly;

SECTION 5. PENALTY. Violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Pesos (P50.00) but not exceeding One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) or by an imprisonment of not less than three (3) days but not exceeding thirty (3) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court;

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its posting;
