MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 17-07-187

AN ORDINANCE AWARDING INCENTIVES TO WINNING ATHLETES, COACHES IN THE PROVINCIAL MEET, MIMAROPARAA MEET, PALARONG PAMBANSA, PHILIPPINE NATIONAL YOUTH GAMES BATANG PINOY, INTERNATIONAL SPORTS COMPETITION AND OTHER SCHOOL-BASED OR SCHOOL-ORGANIZED AND GOVERNMENT SPONSORED ATHLETIC COMPETITIONS IN ALL LEVELS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

“WHEREAS, it has always been the thrust of the Municipal Government of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro to develop athletes and hone their skills and abilities to prepare them from important sports competitions in the future;

“WHEREAS, there are numerous athletes in this Municipality who are possessed of the talents and skills in their respective fields in sports and they have displayed these strong qualities by winning in different levels of sports competitions like Palarong Pampaaran, MIMAROPARAA meet, Palarong Pambansa, Philippine National Youth Games-Batang Pinoy;

“**WHEREAS**, the medals awarded to them are clear manifestation of the values of discipline, patience, hardwork and determination that they have practiced and made a part of their lives;

“**WHEREAS**, the exceptional talents and skills of the Mindoreño athletes in their respective fields in sports would undoubtedly propel their chance to participate in international sports competition;

“**WHEREAS**, it is highly imperative that their achievements be given due recognition because they have carved the names of their schools, units and most of all their mother province in the pillars of victory;


“**WHEREAS**, while these athletes have already set their goals and weaved their dreams of winning in higher levels of competition, it is the role of the Municipal Government of Oriental Mindoro to provide them with the much needed inspiration, assistance and incentive for them to reach their goals and fulfill in their dreams in sports;

“**WHEREAS**, winning is everything and those who achieve it will no doubt leave a lasting sports legacy to the motherland and an undying inspiration to the youth of this Municipality who would also dare to win;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO THAT:

SECTION 1: DEFINITION OF TERMS:

- a) **Incentive**- Cash award to be given to an athlete who wins a gold, silver and bronze medal in an event in the annual Palarong Panlalawigan, Southern Tagalog Regional Athletic Association Meet, Palarong Pambansa, and the Philippine National Youth Games- Batang Pinoy;
- b) **Palarong Pampaaralan**- the third stage of annual scholastic sports competition in the provincial level also known as the Provincial Meet which is conducted by the Department of Education and participated in by student athletes from different school districts or units in all levels and types of educational institutions, both public and private.
- c) **MIMAROPARAA Meet**- the fourth stage of annual scholastic sports competition in the regional level conducted by the Department of Education and participated in by the students from different school divisions in all levels and types of educational institutions, both public and private.
- d) **Palarong Pambansa**- the fifth stage of annual scholastic sports competition in the national level conducted by the Department of Education and participated in by the student athletes from the different regions in the country in all levels and types of educational institutions, both public and private.



- e) **Philippine National Youth Games- Batang Pinoy-** a component national sports exposure program of the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), Department of Education, Department of Interior and Local Government, Leagues of Provinces, Cities, Municipalities and Barangays, the Philippine Olympic Committee (POC), National Sports Associations (NSA'S) and the various national government agencies and non-government organizations (NGO's). It is designed to provide additional sporting activities for Filipino children while instilling in them the importance of Physical Fitness, Play and Sports Education, thus helping minimize juvenile delinquency.
- f) **International Sports Competitions-** international sports events participated in by athletes from different countries or nations and sanctioned, and or authorized by the President Sports Commission (PSC) or the Philippine Olympic Committee or any of its recognized sports associations.
- g) School-based

SEC. 2. INCENTIVES TO WINNING ATHLETES

There shall be awarded to winning athletes in the foregoing levels of sports competitions, cash incentive for every medal they win as a result of their participation on their respective sports events.

The amount of cash incentive shall vary depending on the level of competition as follows:

Palarong Panglalawigan (PROVINCIAL MEET)

Gold Medal	P 200.00
Silver Medal	P 150.00
Bronze Medal	P 100.00

MIMAROPARAA MEET (Regional Meet)

Gold Medal	P 1,500.00
Silver Medal	P 1,000.00
Bronze Medal	P 500.00

PALARONG PAMBANSA (National Meet)

Gold medal	P 2,500.00
Silver Medal	P 2,000.00
Bronze Medal	P 1,000.00

PHILIPPINE NATIONAL YOUTH GAMES-BATANG PINOY

Gold Medal	P2,500.00
Silver Medal	P2,000.00
Bronze Medal	P1,000.00

INTERNATIONAL SPORTS COMPETITION

Gold Medal	P15,000.00
Silver Medal	P10,000.00
Bronze Medal	P 5,000.00

Provided, that in team events, the number of gold, silver or bronze medals won by a team which correspond to the number of team members shall only be equivalent to one gold, silver or bronze medal and shall therefore entitle the team to the amount of cash incentive that will be awarded an athlete.

Provided further, that a Certificate of Recognition shall be awarded by the Municipal Government of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro to all winning and non-winning provincial athletes for their participation in any of the above sports categories except the Palarong Pampaaralan.

SEC. 3. REQUIREMENTS TO CLAIM


- i. Provincial Meet –
 - a. Memorandum Order from DepEd, Unit III if going to the Provincial Meet;
 - b. Certification from Provincial Sports Committee for Palarong Panlalawigan.
- ii. MIMAROPARAA Meet (Regional Competition)
 - a. Memorandum from DepEd Division Office if going to MIMAROPARAA Meet;
 - b. Certification from MIMAROPARAA Sports Committee.
- iii. PALARONG PAMBANSA (National Competition)
 - a. Memorandum Order from DepEd Regional Director if going to Palarong Pambansa;
 - b. Certification from Palarong Pambansa Sports Committee.

SEC. 4. SOURCE OF FUNDS

The amount of at least One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00) cash incentive shall be included annually in the allocation for Sports Development under the General Fund of the Municipality.


