"RESOLUTION NO. 95-12-097

REQUESTING THE FILIPINO COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS BASED AT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA TO EXTEND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO THE RESIDENTS OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO, PHILIPPINES

"WHEREAS, it is noted with a heavy heart that the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, classified as a Low Income Municipality under Executive Order No. 370, is still devoid of a hospital in this technologically advanced computer are;

"WHEREAS, ailing patients have to be brought to the nearest hospital located some forty-five (45) kilometers, the travel for which is so difficult as the road is too rugged and is could easily be described as backward;

"WHEREAS, the only government office that renders medical services to a population of twenty-four thousand inhabitants is the town's medical center manned by a single physician, one nurse, and a few number of midwives, ill-equipped, short of medicines, the people of this municipality are virtually denied of their basic right to health;

"WHEREAS, the municipal government. faced with financial constraints has to look for assistance from private entities composed of benovolent men and women to address this perennial problem of health; Now: therefore, be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To earnestly request the Filipino Community Organizations based at the United States of America to extend medical assistance to the residents of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, Philippines;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, To authorize Councilor Oscar C. Familiara to personally furnish the concerned Filipino Communities abroad.


