AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 96-06-100 ENTITLED "GRANTING SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE POOR BUT DESERVING GRADUATES OF BULALACAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL BY INCREASING THE ANNUAL FUNDING ALLOCATION FROM P15,000.00 TO P20,000.00.

'WHEREAS, education is essential to nation building as acknowledged by Section 17, Article II in the Declaration of State Policies of the Constitution which provides that the State Policies shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism, nationalism and development.
