**EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE ALFONSO V. UMALI, CONGRESSMAN, 2<sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO FILE A BILL IN CONGRESS ESTABLISHING BULALACAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL SAN ROQUE AND MAUJAO EXTENSION CLASSES BOTH AT THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**"WHEREAS**, it is a Constitutional mandate that the State shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism, nationalism and development. It further provides that the State shall assign the highest budgetary priority to education and that quality and basic education be made accessible to all;

**"WHEREAS**, the Bulalacao National High School at the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is the only secondary school at this town that the students from the southern and northern parts find difficulties in pursuing a high school education considering that its barangays are separated by high mountain ranges and sea waters;


**"WHEREAS**, the establishments of Bulalacao National High School Maujao Extension Class at the south and San Roque Extension Class at the north shall definitely redound to the socio-economic and intellectual benefits of both the parents and the students of that areas;
