RESOLUTION NO. 18-04-072

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE COMMUNITY ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (CENRO), SAN MARIANO, ROXAS, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO CONDUCT ASSESSMENT OF ALL CAVES FOUND WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF BULALACAO FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF CAVE MANAGEMENT PLAN AND MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE DENR AND LGU-BULALACAO RELATIVE TO ITS PROTECTION AND MAINTENANCE

“WHEREAS, the cave represents underground voids in Earth’s crust made by natural processes and they are large enough that adult man can enter in it. Caves form naturally by the weathering of rocks and often extend deep underground. Speleology is the science of exploration and study of all aspects of caves and its environment;

“WHEREAS, caves make landscape diverse, fascinating, and rich in resources including the largest springs and the most productive groundwater on earth and its potential as natural laboratories may be the most significant future use;

“WHEREAS, the most valuable and the most sensitive parts of cave system are the nature made values such as stalactites, stalagmites, cave pillars, rimstone pool, cave pearls and the live world to which cave management has great significance in the protection of these very important parts;

“WHEREAS, through the support and technical assistance of CENRO in identifying and assessment of caves in Bulalacao and taking into consideration the uses and importance of caves, a Cave Management Plan should be formulated in order to maintain and protect the cave system against malicious and continuous destructions; Now, therefore, be it






