GERUNDIO TO GRANT THE REMAINING 272 BAGS OF CERTIFIED PALAY SEEDS ALLOCATED TO THIS MUNICIPALITY UNDER THE HIGH YIELDING TECHNOLOGY ADOPTION (HYTA) PROGRAMS TO FARMERS BADLY AFFECTED BY THE ONSLAUGHT OF TYPHOON JOSIE AND HABAGAT

“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro suffered extreme and various losses in agriculture, livestock and fishing industries caused by Typhoon Josie and Habagat that occurred on July 22, 2018 which brought distress, deep grief and misfortune among its inhabitants particularly the marginalized farmers;

“WHEREAS, Typhoon Josie ruined several transportation facilities such as roads and bridges, houses and other building structures were heavily damaged resulted to social and economic turmoil of the people particularly the poor and helpless families who were quality affected by their natural calamity;

“WHEREAS, the Municipal Agriculture Office accounted and submitted a summary of damage assessment caused by Typhoon Josie in terms of losses in agriculture which shows that affected farmers are identified into 254 comprising an area of 320 hectares with a total value based on production loss of PhP5,709,420.50;






