EARNESTLY REQUESTING HONORABLE HUMERLITO "BONZ" DOLOR, PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO TO BE USED FOR THE RESTORATION AND REHABILITATION OF TOURISM INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES WHICH WERE HEAVILY DAMAGED BY TYPHOON URSULA

"WHEREAS, on December 25, 2019, the Municipality of Bulalacao was hit by Typhoon Ursula which brought strong winds and heavy rains to the entire Municipality for almost four hours wherein an estimated 90% of residential houses and other infrastructural facilities such as roads and bridges were ruined and dilapidated, four persons died and four were reported injured leading to social and economic losses of both the inhabitants and the community;

"WHEREAS, tourism infrastructural facilities were dilapidated, electricity was shut-down and so as the communication network including the water supply system, a total devastation in a true sense of the word leaving behind every family into a feeling of deep grief and misfortune;

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is known to be the tourism hub of the Province that rehabilitation of tourism infrastructural facilities should be given priority particularly now that summer season is near to come in order to restore the tourism industry of the Municipality; **Now, therefore, be it**

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED To: Earnestly request Honorable Humerlito "Bonz" Dolor, Provincial Governor, Province of Oriental Mindoro to extend financial assistance to the Municipality of Bulalacao to be used for the rehabilitation and restoration of tourism infrastructure facilities which were heavily damaged by Typhoon Ursula;
