"WHEREAS, Typhoon Ursula brought remarkable losses in agriculture, livestock and fishing industries, paralyze business activities because electricity was shut-down and so as the communication network including the water supply system, a total devastation in a true sense of the word leaving behind every family into a feeling of deep grief and misfortune;

"WHEREAS, during the tragedy, Vice Mayor Lynette G. Postma of Mansalay, did an inspiring share of her time, efforts and resources to extend continuous support and help through distribution of food and medicine and other relief goods to affected families within the sphere of her capacity to which her act of kindness and generosity truly deserves recognition and appreciation; Now, therefore be it....




