RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE JAPAN INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AGENCY (JICA) TO GRANT SCHOOL BUILDING TO NEWLY ESTABLISHED SECONDARY AND ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS IN GEOGRAPHICALLY ISOLATED AND DEPRESSED AREAS PARTICULARLY IN MANGYAN COMMUNITIES OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“**WHEREAS**, the present administration is focus to expand access and ensuring more Filipinos receive a decent basic education, and to enhance the current educational system, as a means of reducing poverty and improving national competitiveness;

“**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Executive Order No. 370 the Municipality of Bulalacao is considered as a 3rd class municipality hounded with financial constraints, it is located at the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro and according to the 2015 census it has a population of 39,107 people where almost 25 percent of it are indigenous people called Hanunuo-Mangyans;

“**WHEREAS**, Bulalacao, has a municipal government that promotes, upholds, and supports “Education for All” advocacy, the updated number of schools within the municipality are 45 elementary schools including extensions 2 of which are newly established and 22 high schools including extensions 3 of which are newly established;

“**WHEREAS**, the provision of school building to the newly established schools in geographically isolated and depressed areas within the municipality would produce enough classrooms to sustain the teaching capacity based on the teacher-student ratio that would certainly proceed in giving quality education for every learner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To; request the to grant Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) school building to newly established secondary and elementary schools in geographically isolated and depressed areas particularly in Mangyan Communities of the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro.
