MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 18-10-220

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE MUNICIPAL BLOOD COUNCIL IN BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO, PRESCRIBING ITS FUNCTIONS, APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR ITS OPERATION, AND THEREBY REPEALING SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 09-03-9-A

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of the Philippines mandates that the State shall provide health services thus promoting general welfare and social justice among its constituents;

WHEREAS, the same mandate is also emphasized in the 1991 Local Government Code so that local government units would carry out programs, projects, and activities protecting the rights of every Filipino against sickness and life-threatening condition;

WHEREAS, the provision of blood for transfusion, a professional medical service, is among the activities that must be supported and practiced to ensure continuity of life, and a blood council in every locality is therefore a necessity;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, that:

Section 1. Title. This ordinance is entitled as stated and shall be also known as the "2018 Municipal Blood Council Ordinance of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro"

Section 2. Statement of Policy. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao (LGU of Bulalacao) to support or comply with the objectives and provisions of Republic Act No. 7719 known as the "National Blood Services Act of 1994" and entitled "An Act Promoting Voluntary Blood Donation, Providing For An Adequate Supply Of Safe Blood, Regulating Blood Banks, And Providing Penalties For Violation Thereof".

Section 3. Creation. The Municipal Blood Council (MBC) is hereby created with the following composition:

The vice chairperson, secretary, committee chairpersons, and other officers the council opted to have, shall be elected from among the members. Election shall be held in the first week of July every after three (3) years. The first election of the MBC, under this ordinance, shall be done in July 2019. The Special Concerns Unit of the Office of the Municipal Mayor shall facilitate the election, proclamation, and oath-taking. The same unit shall also cause the organization of association of heads of national government agencies in Bulalacao, Bulalacao Voluntary Blood Donors Association, and Bulalacao Chamber of Commerce to ensure their representation to MBC.

Section 4. Functions. The Municipal *Blood* Council shall perform these functions:

- a. Formulate constitution and by-laws and internal policies including the frequency, date, venue, and other details of regular and special meetings;
- b. Formulate annual local blood donation plan in accordance with R.A. 7719 and other laws and policies, for submission to the Sangguniang Bayan for its approval;
- c. Organize public education and advocacy activities to instill public consciousness that voluntary blood donation is a humanitarian act;
- d. Recommend to the Sangguniang Bayan the enactment of an ordinance regarding the establishment, operation, and maintenance of Bulalacao Blood Center (BBC) and appropriation of adequate funds thereof;
- e. Establish, maintain, and strengthen linkage between BBC and local hospital and health providers;
- f. Plan for, and hold regular blood donation activities with wide participation from various sectors;
- g. Recommend to the Provincial Blood Council, Philippine National Red Cross, Provincial Health Office, and to other concerned agencies and offices necessary measures to improve the voluntary blood donation activities, the sound operation and maintenance of blood banks, and implementation of policies regarding orderly distribution of blood;
- h. Coordinate for the implementation and sustainability of the local blood donation;
- i. Source out funds from benevolent individuals, organizations, and agencies to help finance blood donation activities;
- j. Perform other functions as may be assigned by any ordinance or law or by any authority.


The Special Concerns Unit of the Office of the Municipal Mayor shall serve as the repository of documents of the MBC.

Section 5. Appropriation. The amount needed for the maintenance and other operating expenses of the MBC shall be included in the General Fund Annual Budget of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro under the Office of the Municipal Mayor for the next fiscal year and years thereafter based on the budget proposal submitted by the MBC. The Municipal Budget Officer shall ensure that the budget necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance is included in yearly appropriation. The fund allocated for this purpose shall not be allowed for realignment and not be certified as savings unless it served its purpose already within a particular fiscal year.

Section 6. Administrative Provision. Any officer or employee who shall disregard or neglect the implementation of this Ordinance shall be administratively dealt with and such shall be a ground for suspension or dismissal subject to the pertinent provisions of the Civil Service Laws and Rules.

Section 7. Repealing Clause. Special Ordinance No. 09-03-9-A or any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 8. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect. Higher laws or policies inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.
