"WHEREAS, the State in recognition of the elderly enacted Republic Act Numbered 7432 in order to motivate, encourage and maximize senior citizens capability to partake in the task of nation building and to mobilize their families and the communities where they live and to reaffirm the valued Filipino tradition of caring for the old members of the family and the community in general;

"WHEREAS, the enactment of this law is a meaningful State management intervention to operationalize the concepts of productive citizenry, respect and care for the elderly;

"WHEREAS, under the law, cities and municipalities are directed to establish an office for Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) to assist senior citizens in availing themselves of the mutually beneficial privileges solely intended for them, however, financial constraint might hamper this noble objective;


