"WHEREAS, the Family Farm School is a unique agricultural  
school concept patterned after a Spanish Escuelas Familiares Agra-  
rias system which has been proven effective in other countries  
which we wish to establish in the Philippines particularly in the  
Municipality of Bulalacao;

"WHEREAS, at present, there are six (6) Family Farm Schools  
(FFS) in the Philippines and all of them are designed to improve  
the living conditions of the agro-industrial communities by provi-  
ding relevant and quality education that leads to professional  
competence, social responsibility and spiritual growth;

"WHEREAS, the Family Farm School are open to all children of  
poor Filipino farmers spending a week in a "live-in class" at  
school and two weeks in an actual farm demonstrations;


"WHEREAS, we firmly believed that with the establishment of  
a Family Farm School, it is easy for us to achieve a strong agricul-  
tural economy in the near future; Now, therefore, be it


RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request
