RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE DECLARING TALON FALLS SITUATED AT BARANGAY BAGONG SIKAT, BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO AS TOURISM RESERVE AREA

"WHEREAS, it is quoting Erik Torkells of the Time Magazine when he said, "All I can say is that I'd give my left ear for an idle, savage, childish summer that in short, let's be kids again to live in a world, if only for a while, what can happen is that we might stub a toe;

"WHEREAS, tropical forest, trail walkways, no electricity at night, fresh foods, the music is nothing but the chirping of birds and with pristine waters rushing down from the scenic "Talon Falls" untouched by the n civilization truly is an scapel's dream come true in the pursuit for developing eco-tourism which is a two-fold approach towards progress: meaning ecology is protected in a more practical view where dollars could be remitted to our local and national coffers; also it would mean employment for the residents living therein,

"WHEREAS, it is also splendid if the beauty of Talon Falls could be shared to our local tourists to taste the beauty of our nature which is still undiscovered and remarkably untouched,

"WHEREAS, such a beauty should need protective laws and ordinances in order to preserve the nature for the next generation; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Adopt an ordinance declaring Talon Falls situated at Barangay Bagong Sikat, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro as Tourism Reserve Area;

ORDINANCE NO. 02-06-027

DECLARING TALON FALLS SITUATED AT BARANGAY BAGONG SIKAT,
BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO AS TOURISM RESERVE AREA

SPONSOR: Hon. Rosalinda M. Cabagay
CHAIRPERSON: Committee on Environmental Protection

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro.

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF POLICY

It is hereby declared that Local tourism coupled with the idea of pursuing the Constitutional mandate of promoting, developing and protecting the environment in the pursuit of balance ecology, this Ordinance hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. It is hereby declared that Talon Falls located at Barangay Bagong sikat, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro and the immediate environ within the One Hundred Meter Radius (100 m. radius) surrounding thereof as water shed to be a Tourist Spot Reserve.

SECTION 3. That no infrastructures or structures shall be allowed to be erected within the declared area without proper permission from the higher authorities and the Office of the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION 4. Any violation hereof shall be punished by a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00) or imprisonment of six (6) months or both fine and imprisonment depending upon the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 5. All ordinances inconsistent hereof are hereby repealed, modified accordingly.



SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY


This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its approval and posting.






