RESOLUTION NO. 17-09-221

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DILG), OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENTIAL ASSISTANCE ON PEACE PROCESS (OPAPP), DEPARTMENT OF AGRARIAN REFORM (DAR) AND DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (DA) TO KINDLY CONSIDER ADJUSTING THE THICKNESS AND WIDTH OF ALL FARM TO MARKET ROADS TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO FROM SIX (6) INCHES TO NINE (9) INCHES AND FROM FOUR (4) METERS TO FIVE (5) METERS ROAD CARRIAGE RESPECTIVELY

“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is emerging into an Agro-Tourism Community due to its vast land area dedicated to agriculture and the amazing tourist spot destinations attractive to local and foreign tourists;

“WHEREAS, it is understood that the primary concern and priority of the Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR), Department of Agriculture (DA) and the OPAPP-PAMANA is the secondary roads leading to Geographically Isolated and Depressed Areas (GIDA) to which the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is classified under this category;

“WHEREAS, Farm to Market Roads in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro need to be very durable to sustain heavy truck loads of agricultural products passing thru the same road everyday particularly during harvest season;

“WHEREAS, the adjustment of thickness from 6 inches to 9 inches and width from 4 meters to 5 meters prevents early deterioration of road network pavements due to heavy loads and ensure the longer life span of the roads geared towards social and economic benefits of the people and the community; Now, therefore, be it


RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Request the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), Office of the Presidential Assistance on Peace Process (OPAPP), Department of Agrarian Reform (DAR) and Department of Agriculture (DA) to kindly consider adjusting the thickness and width of all farm to market roads to be constructed in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro from six (6) inches to nine (9) inches and from four (4) meters to five (5) meters road carriage respectively;


