### RESOLUTION NO. 20-02-173

REQUESTING THE NATIONAL ANTI-POVERTY COMMISSION (NAPC) TO FACILITATE THE ALLOCATION AND APPROPRIATION OF PHP50M EACH FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF GATOL TO AGONG ROAD IN BARANGAY SAN ROQUE AND TAMBANGAN TO QUIPANGLAO TO SAN JUAN PROPER ROAD IN BARANGAY SAN JUAN, ALL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO TO HELP COUNTER INSURGENCY BY STIMULATING ECONOMIC ACTIVITIES THRU GOOD ROAD NETWORK.

**"WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Bulalacao is on its way to being an agro-eco-tourism destination in the Province of Oriental Mindoro that collaborative hard works from both private and government sectors are applied and gathered together to deliver positive outcome;

**"WHEREAS**, the National Anti-Poverty Commission (NAPC) is a government agency of the Republic of the Philippines that coordinates poverty reduction programs by national and local governments and ensures that marginalized sectors participate in the government decision-making processes; the Municipality of Bulalacao is still considered as a third class municipality with having almost twenty percent of inhabitants are indigenous people that called Hanunuo-Mangyans;
