EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DPWH SOUTHERN MINDORO ENGINEERING DISTRICT, ROXAS, ORIENTAL MINDORO TO FACILITATE THE IMMEDIATE REHABILITATION OF ROADS, ROAD SHOULDERS, BRIDGE AND BRIDGE APPROACHES DESTROYED BY TYPHOON JOSIE AND HABAGAT

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro suffered extreme and various losses in agriculture, livestock and fishing industries caused by Typhoon Josie and habagat that occurred on July 22, 2018 which brought distress, deep grief and misfortune among its inhabitants particularly the marginalized farmers;

"WHEREAS, Typhoon Josie ruined several transportation facilities such as roads and bridges, houses and other building structures were heavily damaged resulted to social and economic turmoil of the people and the community particularly the poor and helpless families who were heavily affected by this natural calamity;

"WHEREAS, there is a need to normalize the present condition of the transportation facilities in Bulalacao from damages caused by heavy floods in order not to hamper the shipment of agricultural inputs needed during planting season;

"WHEREAS, the immediate rehabilitation of roads and bridges will ensure the safety of both the pedestrians and vehicles alike considering that Bulalacao is a national road traversed by buses coming from Manila going to San Jose, Occidental Mindoro; **Now, therefore, be it**






