RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM (DOT) UNDER TOURISM ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT PRIORITIZATION CRITERIA (TRIPPC) TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FOR THE CONCRETING OF ROADS TRAVERSING FROM BAY VIEW TOURIST SITES OF SITIO DAKUTAN AND BISLIG RESORT TO APLAYA TO BALATASAN BAY IN BARANGAY BALATASAN, BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

"WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao is on its way to being an agro-eco-tourism destination in the Province of Oriental Mindoro that collaborative hard works from both government and private sectors are applied and gathered together to deliver the best positive outcome;

"WHEREAS, Bulalacao is a 3rd class municipality located at the southernmost tip of Oriental Mindoro with a population of 44,366 based on 2020 census, 25 percent of which are indigenous people called Hanunuo Mangyan, it has a municipal government that aims to establish an efficient local organization which is responsive to the needs of the locality and effectively manages its resources to sustain growth and development;
