ORDINANCE NO. 10

REQUIRING FISH DEALERS, DRIED OR FRESH FISH TO SECURE SANITARY PERMIT BEFORE DELIVERING SUCH TO OTHER PLACES OF MUNICIPALITIES

WHEREAS, fish dealer in this town to deliver fish to other place without being inspected by the Sanitary Inspector who determine whether such fish is still fresh, in good condition or not;

WHEREAS, inspection by the Sanitary Inspector of the kinds of fresh delivered cannot be undertaken by the Sanitary due to lack of Ordinance, laws and regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE in order to regulate, inspection of the kinds of the kinds of fish delivered by fish dealers, and the payment of inspection fee of such fish, the Sangguniang Bayan hereby Ordinance, that

SECTION 1. Fish dealers are hereby required to submit/present their fish to the Sanitary Inspector for inspection purposes, who determine whether such fish is still in good condition, fresh or not;

SECTION 2. Inspection fee shall be allowed to be delivered unless inspected inspection permit with the attached official receipt to be issued by the Municipal Treasurer or his authorized or his representative before such fish will be delivered;

SECTION 3. No fish commodities shall be allowed to be delivered unless inspected by the Sanitary Inspector and the corresponding fees be paid accordingly;


SECTION 4. Violation of this Ordinance or parts thereof, shall subject the offender to a fine of P 200.00 to P 500.00 and an imprisonment of one to six months at the discretion of the court;

SECTION 5. Ordinance or Ordinances similar to this Ordinance and which provisions are inconsistent to this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately;
