

REQUIRING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS TO SECURE BUSINESS
PLATES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao,
Oriental Mindoro:

SECTION 1. Any person who shall establish, operate or con-
duct any business, trade or activity are hereby required
to secure business plates from the Office of the Municipal
Treasurer, and to pay the amount of One Hundred Pesos
(P100.00) as a fee therefor;

Every person issued an official business plate for the con-
duct of a business or undertaking shall keep the same cons-
piciously posted in plain view at the place of business or
undertaking.

SECTION 2. The business plates required herein shall be
upon termination of the business, surrendered to the Muni-
cipal Treasurer ten (10) days after the said termination;

For purposes hereof, termination shall mean that the busi-
ness operations are stopped completely. Any change in
ownership, management and/or name of the business shall
not constitute termination as contemplated in this Ordinance.


SECTION 3. Ordinances inconsistent hereof are hereby re-
pealed modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. Violation of this Ordinance shall be punished
by a fine of Two Thousand and Five Hundred Pesos (P2,500.00)
or by an imprisonment of six (6) months or both such fine
and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days
after its posting.
