

ORDINANCE NO. 019

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 4-A, SERIES OF 1984

"WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4-A, series of 1984 regulates fees of the manufacturers and dealers of charcoal in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro;

"WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4-A, series of 1984 violates Section 16, Article II of the 1986 constitution which provides that the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

"WHEREAS, the above ordinance appeared to be inconsistent with Ordinance No.35, series of 1993 entitled "Kautusang nagbabawal sa lahat ng mga sasakyan na magkarga ng uling sa nasasakupan ng Bayan ng Bulalacao, Silangang Mindoro";

"WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 4-A, series of 1984 deviates the present Administration thrust of addressing problems concerning proper environmental management geared towards the attainment of an ecologically balanced and sustainable environment; Now, therefore, on motion of Councilor Eduardo C. Acheron duly seconded by all members present;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao:

SECTION 1. All provisions of Ordinance No.4-A, series of 1984 is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its posting.
