MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 21-01-282

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING DUE RECOGNITION AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BULALACAO RESIDENTS AGED 70 YEARS OLD AND ABOVE AS PART OF THE MUNICIPALITY'S EFFORT TO SUPPORT SENIOR CITIZENS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF

WHEREAS, Article XV, Section IV of the Constitution mandates that it is duty of the family to take care of the elderly members but the State may also design programs of social security for them;

WHEREAS, in addition to the above-mentioned provision, Article XIII, Section 11 of the Constitution also provides that the "State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavour to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all people at affordable cost. They shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women and children";

WHEREAS, in consonance with the said Constitutional provisions, the Congress of the Philippines enacted Republic Act No. 7432, otherwise known as the "Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2003 and R.A. 9994, otherwise known as "Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010 as amendment by R. A. 9257" to primarily protect the elder members of the society.

WHEREAS, also Article III Section 447, Paragraph (5) (XVII) of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the Municipality shall approve ordinance which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of basic services and facilities and in addition shall formulate policies and adopt measure mutually beneficial to the elderly and to the community, provide incentives for non-government agencies and entities subject to the availability of funds, appropriate funds to support programs and projects for the benefit of Senior Citizens;

WHEREAS, Senior Citizens belong to a special sector that needs singular attention to promote their social, economic and spiritual aspect of their lives as well as allow them to convey their special concerns;

WHEREAS, Senior Citizen who has attained the age of seventy (70) years or more and such term is closely associated with longevity;

WHEREAS, there are many Senior Citizens and seventy (70) years old above in the Municipality of Bulalacao but this fact is not formally recorded nor acknowledged officially. Considering that they are the living link to our history, appropriate recognition and reward should be accorded to them.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF BULALACAO IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT;

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and cited as "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING DUE RECOGNITION AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BULALACAO RESIDENTS AGED SEVENTY (70) YEARS OR MORE AS PART OF THE MUNICIPALITY'S EFFORT TO SUPPORT SENIOR CITIZENS."

Section 2. REQUIREMENTS and PROCEDURE: Before a Senior Citizen can be recognized and given the appurtenant recognition and financial assistance, the following conditions shall be complied with:

- a. Residents who are seventy (70) years old or more, shall be registered at the Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) of the LGU Bulalacao for proper identification and documentation;
- b. The recipient shall be a bona fide resident of the Municipality of Bulalacao and must show proof of residency for the past two (2) years prior to seventy (70) years of age. In case the recipient is a natural born citizen of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro, this condition is not applicable however he/she should submit proof that he/she was born in Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro;
- c. The Recipient shall be a Filipino Citizen or possessing a dual citizenship or adopted Bulalacaonon;
- d. Upon submission of proper and authentic documents, the Municipality of Bulalacao will grant each of the recipient an amount based on the following age bracket;

• 70-74 years old	-	PhP	500.00
• 75-79 years old	-	PhP	1,000.00
• 80-84 years old	-	PhP	2,000.00
• 85-89 years old	-	PhP	3,000.00
• 90-94 years old	-	PhP	5,000.00
• 95-99 years old	-	PhP	10,000.00
• 100 y/o and above	-	PhP	20,000.00

This financial assistance shall be given only once within their age bracket.

- e. In addition to the abovementioned requirements, the recipient must also submit a copy of the following:

1. OSCA ID
2. Barangay Residency Certificate

Section 3. Disbursement. In case the recipient is not capable to receive the financial assistance in person, the same shall be disbursed in his/her place of residence and the payroll shall be prepared per barangay.

Section 4. Centenarians or one hundred (100) years old and more shall be recognized and be given due recognition on the date of occasion set by the Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs and their remarkable stories shall be published in any local newspaper or other social communications like radio stations, and website, among others.

Section 5. Appropriation. The grant of this recognition and financial assistance shall be based upon the availability of funds for the current year. However, in the next Fiscal Year and thereafter, the fund should be included in the Annual General Appropriation of the Local Government of Bulalacao.

Section 6. Repealing Clause. All existing ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders and other rules and regulations which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.


Section 7. Separability Clause. Should any of these clauses or parts of the ordinance be declared unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, all other remaining portions shall not so affected shall remain valid and in effect.

Section 8. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
