"WHEREAS Section 2 of Republic Act No. 10533 otherwise known as **Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013** declares that the state shall establish, maintain and support a complete, adequate, and integrated system of education relevant to the needs of the people, the country and society-at-large; also the state shall create a functional basic education system that will develop productive and responsible citizens equipped with the essential competencies, skills and values for both life-long learning and employment;

"WHEREAS, since the implementation of K-12 Curriculum, it occurred concerns and challenges to the educational system of the country, its key disadvantages include difficulties with online learning, mismatched student interests, unrealistic curriculum, inadequate facilities, overloaded teaching loads, struggles of non-physical education graduates, and the need for capacity development for teachers to deliver the new standards of education;






