### **RESOLUTION NO. 19-04-059**

**EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE THRU SECRETARY EMMANUEL "MANNY" PINIOL TO GRANT TWENTY (20) UNITS OF SOLAR-POWERED WATER PUMP TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO**

**"WHEREAS**, El Niño Phenomenon is an abnormal weather pattern caused by the warming of the Pacific and can affect air and sea currents. This phenomenon resulted in reduced rainfall that led to dry spell, droughts and stronger typhoons;

**"WHEREAS**, severe drought and associated food insecurity, flooding, rains and temperature rises due to El Niño are causing a wide range of health problems including disease outbreaks, malnutrition, heat stress and respiratory diseases;

**"WHEREAS**, the agriculture sector was heavily affected by El Niño in the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro. Long dry season greatly lead to decrease in agricultural production such as rice and corn and large volumes of cereals, vegetables and fruits including onions and garlic production, all these agricultural losses brought dismay and financial dissatisfaction to the farmers who were already into debt during planting season;

**"WHEREAS**, there should be a response measure to El Niño and a mitigating facility to reduce its ill effects particularly in the agricultural sector, as of today, farmers identified and requested that a solar- powered water pump should be provided unto them so that during long dry season it can be used to water plants; **Now, therefore, be it**

**RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED To:** Earnestly request the Department of Agriculture thru Secretary Emmanuel "Manny" Piniol to grant twenty (20) units of solar-powered water pump to the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro;


