ORDINANCE NO. 16-07-159

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE NEW OFFICIAL SEAL FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro:


SECTION 1. There is hereby adopted the new official seal for the Municipality of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro appended herewith as Annex "A" with the following meaning:

- a. **Fifteen (15) Rays** – represent the 15 barangays of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro namely: Bagong Sikat, Balatasan, Benli, Cabugao, Cambunang, Campaasan, Maasin, Maujao, Millagrosa, Nasucob, Poblacion, San Francisco, San Isidro, San Juan and San Roque. Rays are colored yellow to emphasize bright future ahead for these barangays;
- b. **Leaves** – stand for the richness of Bulalacao's wetland and upland forests;

- c. **Green Badge** – signifies the strong commitment of the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao to protect, conserve, and/or preserve the environment and natural resources;
- d. **Fourteen (14) Grains** – are the representations for 14 barangays which are producers of various agricultural products like palay, corn, onion, garlic, mango, cashew, root crops, coconut and different other fruits and vegetables. Maasin is an island barangay;
- e. **Eight Drops of Water** – symbolize 8 coastal barangays of Balatasan, Maasin, Maujao, Milagrosa, Poblacion, San Francisco, San Juan and San Roque;
- f. **Blue Badge** – is the symbolism for peace-loving, warm and hospitable people of Bulalacao. It also tells about the pristine and rich seas surrounding thirteen (13) beautiful islets which have great potentials to become premier tourist destinations;
- g. **Black Circle** – stands for the abundance of minerals in this Municipality;
- h. **White Sand** – represents the thrust on clean and wholesome tourism industry;
- i. **Wind Mill** – symbolizes the obvious potentials of Bulalacao on becoming the top supplier of renewable energy in Oriental Mindoro;
- j. **Road** – is the representation for the town's aggressive pursuit for progress and development;
- k. **Steering Wheel and Anchor** – stand for the strategic location of Bulalacao as it positions itself to become a very important take-off point to Southern Philippines;
- l. **Mangyan Script** – literally read as "Hanunuo Mangyan", is an apt symbolism for the rich culture, tradition and influence Hanunuo Mangyan indigenous people extend to the whole Municipality;
- m. **Big Badge Shape** – speaks for Bulalacao and its people's commitment to honor democracy, good governance and responsible citizenry;
- n. **Scroll of Knowledge** – confirms the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao's strong support to education towards people empowerment and poverty alleviation;
- o. **Two White Dots** – represent the balance of power between executive and legislative offices.

SEC.2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.


