ORDINANCE NO. 7.

REQUIRING ANY PERSON TO SECURE HEALTH CERTIFICATE

BE IT enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro in session assembled.

SECTION 1. It is unlawful for any person or persons to operate Sari-sari store or engage in the buy and sell of fish Commodities, food commodities, vegetables and others, without Health Certificate issued by the Municipal Health Officer or his duly authorized representatives of this Municipality;

SECTION 2. License or Permit to operate Sari-sari store or to engage in the buy and sell of any kinds, mentioned in Section I hereof, shall be issued only to person upon presentation of her/his Health Certificate;

SECTION 3. Payment in the amount of FIVE (P5.00) PESOS for every Health Certificate issued shall be made in the Office of the Municipal Treasurer or his duly authorized representatives;

SECTION 4. Health Certificate issued by the Municipal Health Officer or his duly authorized representatives shall be paid annually;


SECTION 5. Violation of this Ordinance or parts hereof shall be fined the amount of FIFTY (P50.00) PESOS or more but not exceeding One Hundred (P100.00) PESOS and an imprisonment of 15 days or more but not exceeding 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 6. Ordinance or Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
