RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, DIVISION OF ORIENTAL MINDORO THRU SCHOOLS DIVISION SUPERINTENDENT, SUSANA M. BAUTISTA TO ENDORSE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF BULALACAO NORTH DISTRICT AND BULALACAO SOUTH DISTRICT IN BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

WHEREAS, pursuant to Executive Order No. 370 the Municipality of Bulalacao is considered as a 3rd class municipality; it is located at the southernmost tip of the Province of Oriental Mindoro that has a distinct geographical features and according to 2015 census it has a population of 39, 107 people;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 9155 otherwise known as the Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001, it provided a framework for the governance of education, decentralizing governance to the field, and making the schools and learning centers the heart of the education system, the law also established the authority and accountability of the various organization levels of the Department of Education (DepEd);

WHEREAS, the updated number of schools within the Municipality of Bulalacao are 46 elementary schools including extensions and 22 high schools including extensions;


WHEREAS, dividing the Municipality of Bulalacao into 2 districts would enhance service delivery thru manageable scope of supervision, management, communication and other necessary interventions; these two districts shall facilitate separately their supervision of schools and administration of activities,
Now, therefore, be it;

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Request the Department of Education, Division of Oriental Mindoro thru Schools Division Superintendent, Susana M. Bautista to endorse the establishment of Bulalacao North District and Bulalacao South District in Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro.
