EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE SECRETARY, DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO CREATE TWENTY (20) TEACHING POSITIONS FOR THE BULALACAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL MAIN AND ITS TWO (2) EXTENSION CLASSES AT MAUJAO AND SAN ROQUE, ALL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, it is a Constitutional mandate that the State shall assign the highest budgetary priority to education and that basic and quality education be made available to all;

“WHEREAS, in consonant with the abovementioned constitutional mandate, the Municipal Government of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro facilitated the establishment of two (2) secondary extension classes known as Bulalacao National High School (BNHS) Maujao at the south and San Roque at the north to make secondary education more accessible to all;


“WHEREAS, the maintenance and other operating expenses including the salaries and other emoluments of teachers assigned at the abovementioned classes are all financed by the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao that additional teachers for the increasing enrollees add burden considering that this Municipality is Pro-Poor;


