REQUESTING THE BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES THROUGH THE BFAR, REGIONAL OFFICE, CALAPAN CITY TO EXTEND TECHNICAL, TECHNOLOGICAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO ON OYSTER AND MUSSELS CULTURE

“WHEREAS, shellfish culture is the most important aquaculture activity because it provides livelihood to coastal communities to increase income for the family;

“WHEREAS, oyster and mussels farming can also help fishing pressure in our fished waters as it diversifies the sources of income of a fishermen not relying all the time to fishing when it is difficult during the inclement of bad weather condition;

“WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bulalacao, Province of Oriental Mindoro is composed of eight (8) coastal barangays whose main source of living comes from fishing. According to experts in shellfish culture, oyster and mussels industry is feasible in the coastal areas given the appropriate funds and technical knowledge of oyster biology as related to culture, various systems of culture and their relative efficiencies, hydrographic conditions favoring high production, importance of pollution free water, local availability of broodstock, seed and health regulations relating to molluscs are often the keys to successful culture operation ; **Now, therefore, be it**




