RESOLUTION NO. 16-05-044

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY THROUGH ITS GENERAL MANAGER TO GRANT EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS AND AUTHORITY TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE BULALACAO FISHING PORT, BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

“WHEREAS, the adequate provision of fishing ports and post-harvest facilities is critical to the full development of the Philippine fisheries sector where catch can be immediately sold, stored, processed or shipped to markets so that post-harvest losses could be significantly reduced;

“WHEREAS, the Bulalacao Fishing Port established several years ago thru the concerted effort of the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) and the Local Government of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro is perceived to be under utilized with limited fishing activities perhaps, due to mis-management of the private entity such as the MBL Cargo Transport Services which according to them the rights to operate was granted by the Philippine Ports Authority unto them;

“WHEREAS, it is sad to say that MBL monopolizes the fishing, cargo and handling activities of the Bulalacao Fishing Port since its operation giving zero share of revenue to the Local Government Unit;


“WHEREAS, Presidential Decree No. 977 created the Philippine Fish Marketing Authority (PFMA) tasked to address fish marketing problems to which it was renamed later as Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) by virtue of Executive Order No. 965 task to manage all fishing ports in the country however, with the implementation of the Local Government Code of 1991, the control over all municipal ports has been devolved to the Local Government Units concerned; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, To: Earnestly request the Philippine Ports Authority through its General Manager to grant exclusive rights and authority to the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro the operation and maintenance of the Bulalacao Fishing Port, Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro.






