MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 20-02-254

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS IN THE USE OF AMBULANCE AND EMERGENCY TRANSPORT VEHICLE OWNED, OPERATED, AND MAINTAINED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BULALACAO, ORIENTAL MINDORO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro that:

Section 1. Definition of terms.

Ambulance refers to the vehicle identified and used by the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao (LGU-Bulalacao) in transporting and transferring patients.

Emergency transport vehicle refers to the vehicle other than the ambulance identified and used by the LGU of Bulalacao in transporting and transferring patients.

Section 2. In non-emergency situations like scheduled check-ups or medical consultations, the request for the services of an ambulance or emergency transport vehicle (ETV) shall be approved provided there would be at least two (2) ambulance or ETV vehicles left and readily available within the municipality, and provided further that all expenses including fuel and travel expenses of driver shall be shouldered by the requesting party.

Section 3. In emergency situations, the LGU of Bulalacao shall provide immediate ambulance or ETV services with medical personnel and driver to the following patients:

- a. confined or admitted to a birthing facility, infirmary, or hospital within the municipality but needed to be transferred to a primary or higher level hospital;
- b. those who were given first-aid treatment by health professionals but needed to be confined or admitted to a primary or higher level hospital.

No fees shall be charged for these situations provided the patient is conducted within the province of Oriental Mindoro. The travelling expenses of medical personnel and driver shall be charged in appropriate funds under the maintenance and other operating expenses in the Office of the Municipal Mayor. The fuel shall be charged against the assistance for individuals in crisis situations (AICS) given to indigent clients.

The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) shall make assessment and recommendation whether the LGU of Bulalacao shall shoulder or not the travelling expenses of the medical personnel and driver, arrastre and bill of lading fees, toll and parking fees, and fuel in connection with the transport or transfer of patients to higher level hospital outside the province. The Local Chief Executive (LCE) or his duly authorized representative must immediately act on the recommendation.

Section 4. Ambulance and ETV drivers shall be trained for basic life support and shall be educated on traffic privileges and rights concerning the ambulance. No ambulance or ETV shall transport or transfer patients without the assistance of a medical professional with instructions from the concerned medical doctor. All ambulance and ETVs of the LGU of Bulalacao should have the necessary equipment, tools, gadgets and supplies.

The LCE shall designate a focal person for dispatching and scheduling ambulance and ETV and through the Municipal Administrator and General Services Officer, shall ensure that all ambulance and ETVs are properly registered with the Land Transportation Office and covered with the necessary insurance annually;

As much as possible, the ambulance and ETV shall not be used in transporting cadaver. Procurement or assignment of a vehicle for the sole purpose of transporting cadaver is hereby recommended.

Section 5. Fund. The fund needed for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be charged against the Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses of the Office of the Municipal Mayor for the current year and for years thereafter. AICS, if necessary, shall be charged against the fund for donation in MSWDO.

Disbursement shall only be allowed upon presentation of necessary documents as may be required by the Municipal Accounting Office.

Ordinance No. 20-02-254...
Section 6. Administrative Provision. Any officer or employee of the LGU of Bulalacao who shall disregard or neglect the implementation of this Ordinance shall be administratively dealt with and such shall be a ground for suspension or dismissal subject to pertinent provisions of the Civil Service Commission laws and rules.

Section 7. Repealing Clause. Any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 8. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect. Higher laws or policies inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail.


Section 9. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after fifteen (15) days of posting in bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Local Government Unit of Bulalacao.


